



## **School Facilities**

When CCA resumes school in school buildings, school facilities will be ready to receive students. There will be, of course, operational adjustments to mitigate concerns related to COVID-19. These are examples of the operational adjustments in the area of School Facilities.

Over the summer:

- CCA will undergo a deep cleaning using anti-microbial products to ensure that surfaces stay clean and sanitized for longer periods.
- CCA will have hand sanitizer dispensers installed in every classroom and throughout the building so that students can use.
- CCA will have signage added that speak to the safety measures we recommend including:
  - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
  - If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
  - Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
  - Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash
  - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- CCA will have 6 ft. markers in the sidewalks and buildings to support social distancing.

During the day,

- custodians will wear face coverings such as face masks
- CCA will have hand sanitizer dispensers and soap dispensers regularly monitored to refill as needed.

Throughout the school year,

- CCA will undergo several cleaning and sanitizing protocols on a daily, weekly and monthly basis using anti-microbial products.
