Eligibility Requirements for Honors Classes

- Students will have an option to take honors courses for ELA, Math, and Science.
- Students with an 80-semester average and a standardized test score in the 40th percentile for those courses will be recommended for the honors program.
- In order to remain in the honors program, a student must maintain an 80-semester average in all honors courses.
