Homeroom Moms

Each class has at least one volunteer homeroom mom. The homeroom mom helps the teacher with the different fundraising events and school activities.

Colonial Holiday

Colonial Holiday is our annual fall fundraiser. This two day event takes place in November. Each classroom is transformed into a different Colonial theme and students have different roles to perform based on their classroom theme. We open our campus on Thursday for public schools to come on field trips and enjoy our Colonial Holiday. Friday night is open to the public.

This time also depends heavily on parent volunteers for classroom setup, baked goods donations and classroom takedown. Teachers will provide more information once Colonial Holiday gets closer.

Gala

Gala is our annual Spring fundraiser. It is a themed evening of dinner, entertainment, and a combination of live and silent auctions. CCA families are asked to donate an item to be auctioned or donate a monetary amount. Each class will have a classroom project that will be

auctioned during our live auction. Volunteers are essential in making this evening a success.

School Events

Middle school conference- First 3 days of school, designed to help students learn the ropes of middle school.

Student performances- Parents are welcome to attend these events. Veteran's Day, Grandparents Day, Pastor Appreciation, Christmas Program, talent show.

Class parties- Throughout the year we celebrate different holidays and events. If you volunteer to bring an item please make sure there are no characters on them. Also, make sure you are aware of any food allergies if bringing food. *No Santa, Easter bunny, cartoons, etc.

Polar Express- Is a school activity where kids come to school in the evening in their pajamas and blankets. They have pizza, play games and watch movies in their classroom. The fee to attend goes towards Gala class projects that will be auctioned off.

Dr. Seuss Week- This week-long event has different themed days where students are able to come dressed according to the theme. A list will be provided by your teacher. A breakfast with Dr. Seuss and characters is held on Friday before school for a small fee.

Speech Meet- Preparing our children in public speaking is an important tool. Students (1st-10th) can choose between a poem, Bible verse, fable and other categories to present during designated evaluations from a panel of judges. Scoring criteria will be sent home. The top ranking will

be presented medals and will move on to district meets in San Antonio.

Field trips- Grades 2nd-5th participate in field trips.

Muffins with Moms- Is held during the beginning of May. Muffins and beverages are provided for a quick breakfast before school to celebrate mom.

Donuts with Dads- Is held during the end of May. Donuts and beverages are provided for a quick breakfast before school to celebrate dad.

Field day- This event is scheduled towards the end of the year. It is a fun-filled day of outdoor activities (grades 1st-10th) and indoor activities (K2-K) Each grade level receives a field day shirt to wear during activities.

Clubs and Extracurricular Activities

Every year our teachers provide different themed clubs. Stay tuned to learn more about which clubs will be offered.

This past year CCA implemented a new sports program. We offer Flag football, Volleyball, Basketball and Cross Country. Our Athletic Director, Coach Molina, also holds a sports camp (for a monthly fee) after school to introduce our students to the fundamentals of the different sports.
